

UP NORTH VINTAGE MARKET VENDOR APPLICATION

We are seeking quality vendors in the following categories:

1. Antiques (older cabin style furnishings including wicker, rattan, rustic, twig, Rittenhouse, Habitant, and good solid old wood dressers, tables, etc.)
2. Vintage painted furniture (chalk painted and distressed furniture items suitable for use in the home, on the porch, or in the yard)
3. Repurposed items made from old parts (potting benches, decorative frames, shelves and other items made from windows, drawers, etc.)
4. Vintage or handmade garden décor (birdhouses, planted chairs, etc.)
5. Vintage fishing and hunting items (wooden lures, creels, old oars, floats, nets, traps, nautical instruments, taxidermy, etc.)
6. Vintage or artisan jewelry and clothing items
7. Handmade soaps, perfumes, or other toiletries
8. Specialty food and bakery items covered under the Michigan Cottage Food Law or prepared in an inspected kitchen as required. Please submit a copy of your license if applicable to clerk@markeytownship.org

Vendor booths are about 150 sq.ft. with 15 ft. of frontage and 10 ft. depth. each booth is \$25.00. You may rent more than one booth if needed. We prefer all merchandise vendors bring their own 10'x10' pop-up tent for continuity throughout the market. If there is some reason you cannot do this, please let us know ahead of time and we will place you accordingly.

We are also seeking a couple of food trucks, one specializing in great coffee and unique breakfast items, and one or two with some unique luncheon items that would not be available at the Spikehorn restaurant across the street. Please submit your food license, menu, with prices, and photos of your business set-up to. Food Trucks will be charged by the amount of space their operation takes up. Generally, two spaces or \$50.00 is likely, which allows for 30 ft. of frontage and 10 ft. depth.

To become a vendor, you must submit this application along with three (3) photos of your set-up and merchandise to Markey Township, 7400 E. Houghton Lake Dr., Houghton Lake, MI 48629 or email to clerk@markeytownship.org.

We would like to offer the opportunity to local musicians to set up free in our gazebo and play a set or two on market days during the hours of 10 and 3, longer if you don't want to stop. We cannot pay you, but you are welcome to pass the hat or set up a tip jar, and it would be great exposure in front of a crowd. Please submit a tape to the clerk at Markey Township for approval.

When your application has been approved, you will be notified to send in your vendor booth rent. Booth rent must be received one week prior to initial set-up. For each additional market you choose to do, booth rent will be collected at the end of the previous market.

All vendors agree that Markey Township and Market Managers Rick and Laura Nickerson are not responsible for any damage or theft to personal property during set-up, tear down, or actual open market hours. Your signature below confirms you are in agreement with this statement.

In the event of rain, or other bad weather on the morning of a market day, the rain date will be the following day, on Sunday. It must actually be raining and forecast to continue for a rain date to be called. You are responsible to bring your own tarps or anything your set-up may need in the event of a shower after the market begins for the day. Text the Market Manager in the morning to determine whether a rain date has been called.
