

Markey Township Board Meeting
April 12, 2010

The Markey Township Board met in regular session at the Township Hall Monday, April 12, 2010. The meeting was called to order and the pledge of allegiance was recited. Board members Hagerty, Rons, Willoughby, Van Ostenbridge, and Ciaramitaro were present, as well as sixteen citizens.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by Willoughby to approve the agenda. Motion passed.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by Van Ostenbridge to approve the consent agenda, minus the bills payable. Motion passed.

There was discussion in regards to the Nextel invoice. Motion made by Van Ostenbridge, seconded by Willoughby to approve payment of all bill payable. Motion passed.

Supervisor Hagerty introduced Larry Boyce candidate for state representative of the 103rd district. He spoke about his qualifications and also his goals if he is elected to office.

Chief Cleeves presented the board with the Fire Department 2010 plan. A 3-5 year plan and 5-10 year plan have also been written, and will be reviewed and revised every quarter.

Motion made by Van Ostenbridge, seconded by Rons to accept the 2010 road plan that was presented to the township by the Road Commission. Motion passed.

There was discussion on the renewal of the township blue cross coverage. It was decided to table this discussion until more information can be gathered.

Motion made by Rons, seconded by Willoughby not to call back the previous part time maintenance person. Motion passed.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by Rons to hire Joe Van Ostenbridge as the part time maintenance person. He is an at-will employee. Willoughby, Hagerty and Rons voted aye, Ciaramitaro voted nay, and Van Ostenbridge abstained. Motion passed.

Motion made by Rons, seconded by Hagerty to pay Van Ostenbridge \$10.00 per hour. Motion passed.

Motion made by Van Ostenbridge, seconded by Hagerty to allow the township to seek bids for lawn mowing of the township properties. Motion passed.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by Rons to make changes in the Markey Township Employee Handbook section D, Illegal Drugs and Abuse of Alcohol, and section E, Private Vehicles. Motion passed.

Resolution made by Willoughby and Hagerty to approve changes to the Crestview Cemetery Ordinance #40, less Section 8, Item H. Roll call Vote: Willoughby, Hagerty, Rons, Ciaramitaro, and Van Ostenbridge voted aye. Nays: None. Resolution passed. A copy of these changes is attached and made part of these minutes.

Resolution made by Hagerty to approve the Solid Waste Management Ordinance #46. Roll call vote: Ayes: Van Ostenbridge, Willoughby, Hagerty, Rons, and Ciaramitaro. Nays: None. Resolution passed. A copy of this ordinance is attached and made part of these minutes.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by Rons to set road brining dates for May 5th, June 16th, and August 18th 2010. Motion passed.

Discussion about giving the park with the soccer and baseball fields a name. Van Ostenbridge and Ciaramitaro will form a committee to look into this matter.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by Rons to approve the revised Fire Department, Policy for Purchases & Services. Motion passed.

A Resolution made by Hagerty, seconded by Willoughby rescind the Payment In Lieu of Benefit. Roll Call Vote: Hagerty, Rons, Ciaramitaro, Van Ostenbridge, and Willoughby. Nays: None. Resolution passed.

Comments were heard from citizens.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by Van Ostenbridge to adjourn the meeting. Meeting adjourned at 8:13 PM.
