Markey Township Board met for a regular meeting at the Township Hall on Monday, May 10, 2010. The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM, and the pledge of allegiance was recited. Present: Supervisor Hagerty, Clerk Rons, Treasurer Willoughby, Trustee Ciaramitaro, Trustee VanOstenbridge, and eighty-seven concerned citizens.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by VanOstenbridge to approve the agenda. Motion passed.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by VanOstenbridge to approve the consent agenda with correction and removal of the accounts payable. Motion passed.

Motion made by VanOstenbridge, seconded by Ciaramitaro to approve accounts payable.

Hagerty introduced Norm Fullmer, Democratic candidate. He spoke briefly about his desire to be elected county commissioner.

Motion made by Rons, seconded by VanOstenbridge to accept the Community Blue PPO #4, Alternative Plan #2. Motion passed.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by VanOstenbridge to award the lawn maintenance bid for the Crestview Cemetery to Tim's Lawn care & Snowplowing. The price will be \$235.00 per cut. Motion passed.

Motion made by Rons, seconded by Ciaramitaro to allow the County Christian Softball league to use the township softball fields on Tuesday and Thursday evenings during the months April thru August. Motion passed.

Motion made by Willoughby, seconded by Rons to allow the supervisor and clerk sign the agreement for collection of summer school property taxes. The school district agrees to pay the township \$3.00 per parcel. Motion passed.

Resolution 2010-05-10 made by Hagerty, seconded by Willoughby to establish a \$75.00 fee to review land division requests. Roll Call Vote; Aye: VanOstenbridge, Willoughby, Hagerty, Rons, and Ciaramitaro. Nay: None. Resolution passed.

Resolution 2010-05-11 made by Hagerty, seconded by Rons to adopt the Land Division Ordinance #30. Roll Call Vote; Aye: Willoughby, Hagerty, Rons, Ciaramitaro, and Van Ostenbridge. Nays: None. Resolution passed.

Resolution 2010-05-12 made by Hagerty, seconded by Rons to adopt amended Ordinance #24 with changes made on May10, 2010. Copy of attached amended ordinance attached to and made part of these minutes. Roll Call Vote; Aye: Hagerty, Rons, Ciaramitaro, VanOstenbridge, and Willoughby. Nay: None. Resolution passed.

The board meeting was closed and opened for public comments. Board members, residents, and fire/ems personal debated for quite some time on rescinding Ordinance #24.

Motion made by Willoughby, seconded by Hagerty to open the board meeting back up. Motion passed.

Resolution 2010-05-14 made by Willoughby, seconded by Ciaramitaro to reinstate the original, Ordinance #24 that was effective April 1993. Roll Call Vote: Aye: Ciaramitaro, VanOstenbridge, Willoughby, Hagerty, and Rons. Nays: None. Resolution passed.

Public comments were heard.

Motion made by Willoughby, seconded by Hagerty to adjourn the meeting at 9:24 PM. Motion passed.
