

MARKEY TOWNSHIP BOARD
REGULAR MEETING
Monday, June 13, 2011

Regular meeting of the Markey Township Board called to order at 7:00 p.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance. Board Members Present: Joanne Kortge, Sheryl Tussey, Wendy Bell, Norm Fullmer and Sherrie Ciaramitaro.

Motion by Ciaramitaro, seconded by Tussey to approve agenda as amended. All in favor. Motion carried. Added treasurer's report and approval of bills.

Motion made by Kortge, seconded by Fullmer to approve minutes from May. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion made by Kortge, seconded by Fullmer to approve treasurer's report. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion made by Kortge, seconded by Ciaramitaro to approve bills. All in favor. Motion carried.

Public Comment: Residents from Dale Rd are unhappy with the flooding on Dale Rd and would like to have something done about it as soon as possible.

Correspondence:

Roscommon County Solid Waste Recycling Committee will not continue their feasibility study for Roscommon County due to one township not willing to participate.

Reports:

Ordinance: Reported for April and May. There were 14 permits issued and a total of \$280 collected for April. There were 10 permits issued and a total of \$840 collected for May.

Planning Commission: Held one Public Hearing and one regular meeting since last report. Wendy Bell was approved for a Bed & Breakfast. There will be a Public Hearing for Showers Pot of Gold on July 7th, 2011 at 6:30 p.m. Tornado Sirens were discussed. Turned over to the Board.

Fire Department: 36 Total runs; 7 Fire runs and 29 EMS runs. Received one quote to replace the narrow band repeater, waiting on two more bids.

We can now transport patients back from the hospital, if doctor ordered, within our township. This will help generate some more revenue.

Assessor: A Homestead audit is being conducted. Land Use Permits have been checked and field work will begin next week. Three citizens have requested review of their property. One has been completed. July 19th will be the Clerical "Board of Review".

Fire Department Matters:

Motion made Kortge, seconded Tussey to change Kelly J Van-Y to Captain effective 6/1/11. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion made Fullmer, seconded by Kortge to change Nick Sergeant to Lieutenant effective 6/1/11. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion made Kortge, seconded by Fullmer to refer the violation complaint of the Anti-Blight and Nuisance-Type Activity Ordinance against Ken Gibson to Mr. Scott Hess, Markey Township Attorney, for resolution. Roll call vote: Fullmer - aye, Ciaramitaro – aye, Tussey – aye, Kortge – aye, Bell – aye. Motion carried.

Motion made Fullmer, seconded by Kortge to adopt the new Ordinance Complaint Form to be used for residence having a legitimate complaint. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion made Kortge, seconded by Ciaramitaro to accept the resignation of Joe Miracle from the Fire Department, with regrets, effective 6-1-11. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion made Kortge, seconded by Fullmer to accept the resignation of Ken Nebor from the Fire Department, with regrets, effective 5/25/11. All in favor. Motion carried.

Motion made Tussey, seconded by Kortge to accept Josephine Ruby as a new member of the Fire Department, effective 6/13/11. All in favor. Motion carried.

Norm Fullmer gave a report regarding the upcoming need to replace signs in the township. He got his information from the Roscommon County Road Commission.

Channel Court/Dale Road Project information up-date: Joanne Kortge went w/local excavator to this area and Norm Fullmer went with Tim O'Rourke. This area was prioritized as a #3 project by the RCRC in July of 2009. On Friday, 6/17/11, there is a meeting at 10 a.m. with Marv Myers & Paxton Engineering. Everyone is welcome to attend.

Motion made by Kortge, seconded by Tussey to pay Karl McCarn, part time maintenance person, \$9 per hour. All in favor. Motion carried.

Public Comment:

Bill Steeby mentioned what a great job Tom Burge had done when he took over the Greenbriar Street issue. He also said that Steve Hall has done a great job as well. He was pleased with Joanne's comments also.

Motion made by Kortge, seconded by Fullmer to adjourn at 8:00 p.m. All in favor. Motion carried.
