Board members and citizens arbitrated the fire/ambulance special assessment, garbage fee and mileage rates for the fiscal year 4-1-11 to 3-31-12.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by Rons to adjourn the hearing and enter into the regular meeting at 7:05 PM. Motion passed.

Motion made by Rons, seconded by Hagerty to approve the agenda. Motion passed.

Motion made by Ciaramitaro, seconded by Van Ostenbridge to approve the consent agenda. Motion passed.

Hagerty introduced Dorothy Sunman, executive chairperson for Roscommon County Democratic Party. Ms. Sunman informed the board and citizens exactly how a recall works and affects the township.

Hagerty introduced Joel Sheltron, Democrat who spoke on his campaign as State Representative.

Resolution 2010-09-02 made Hagerty, seconded by Rons to keep the Fire/Ambulance Assessment at 2.500. Roll call vote: Ayes: Willoughby, Hagerty, Rons, Ciaramitaro, and Van Ostenbridge. Nays: None. Resolution passed.

Resolution 2010-09-03 made by Hagerty, seconded by Willoughby to reduce the Garbage Collection Fee to \$65.00 per month. Roll call vote: Ayes: Hagerty, Rons, Ciaramitaro, Van Ostenbridge, and Willoughby. Resolution passed.

Resolution 2010-09-04 made by Hagerty, seconded by Van Ostenbridge to set the millage for the General Fund at 1.0795. Roll call vote: Rons, Ciaramitaro, Van Ostenbridge, Willoughby, and Hagerty. Resolution passed.

Resolution 2010-09-05 made by Hagerty, seconded by Hagerty, seconded by Ciaramitaro to set the Road Fund millage at .9638. Roll call vote: Ciaramitaro, Van Ostenbridge, Willoughby, Hagerty, and Rons. Resolution passed.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by Rons to allow the township to sign the Right-of-Way Telecommunications Permit as described in the Metro Act Permit, revision 12-06-02. Roll Call Vote: Van Ostenbridge, Willoughby, Hagerty, Rons, and Ciaramitaro. Motion passed.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by Van Ostenbridge to approve a budget adjustment of for planning commission education. Motion passed.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by Van Ostenbridge to make a total of \$13,700.00 budget adjustment to the general fund. A list of amounts and account numbers are attached and made part of these minutes. Motion passed.

Motion made by Rons, seconded by Van Ostenbridge to set fall leaf pick-up dates on Wednesday, October 6, October 20, and November 3. Motion passed.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by Rons to allow the township to spend an additional \$400.00 for welding repairs needed on the flail mower. Motion passed.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by Rons to appoint Thomas Burge as temporary Ordinance Administrator until the position is filled with a part time employee. Burge's rate of pay will be \$9.10 per hour. Motion passed.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by Van Ostenbridge to approve township employees the ability to attend MTA educational classes. Motion passed.

Several citizens expressed public comments.

Motion made by Hagerty, seconded by Ciaramitaro to adjourn the meeting at 8:22 PM. Motion passed.
